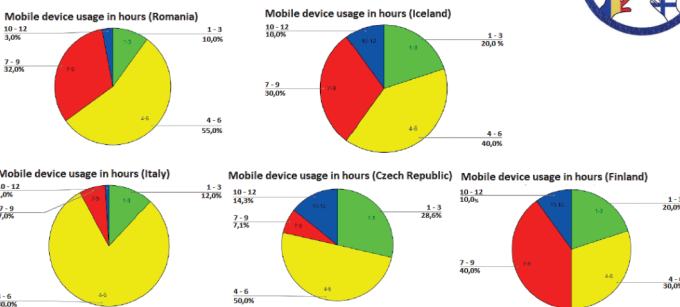
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Does the device usage differ between participating schools?



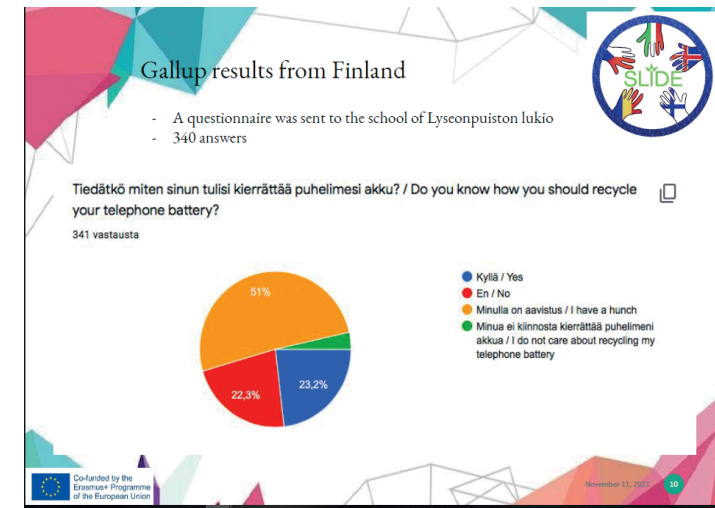
Project summary

The aim of this interdisciplinary project entitled "Sustainable Lifestyle in Digital Environments" is to offer secondary school students from five European countries the opportunity of international co-operation on the important topics for young people living in a digital environment. The project approached them as active citizens in a digital world and their multifaceted roles as digital consumers from different perspectives closely linked to school subjects.

Five secondary schools from Romania, Iceland, the Czech Republic, Finland and Italy took part in the project.

Equal opportunities to participate were given to students aged from 16 to 18. The involved students and teachers explored sustainable lifestyle in digital environments through five groups with different but interconnected topics. The topics were as follows: search engines, virtual world, map services, digital travel documents, and hardware and software related questions. The groups investigated the topics through intensive co-operation and use of digital databases.

The project greatly improved students' and teachers' understanding of sustainable lifestyle and digital environments, as well as their communicative and critical thinking skills.
